

# TALANOA-WATER Second General Assembly

31 May – 1 June 2023 In person meeting hosted by Universidad de Salamanca, Spain









## Motivation and objectives

On the 31<sup>st</sup> of May 2023, TALANOA-WATER partners will submit the 2<sup>nd</sup> 12-month Progress Report to PRIMA and will complete the first half of the lifetime of the project.

The General Assembly of Salamanca will take place during the two days of the meeting, and gather in person the Project Steering Committee to 1) conduct a general review of the progress of the project as reflected in the draft of te second progress report (which will be sent for review to all partners ahead of the meeting) and project deliverables; 2) collectively assess the gaps in project implementation that have been identified by the coordination unit at USAL, as well as in the general review; and 3) agree and issue a timely response to the delays through contingency planning. A part of day 2 will dedicated to a discussion on stakeholder engagement through serious gaming (1st June).



Escuelas Mayores (historical building of University of Salamanca). The classroom is dedicated to Miguel de Unamuno, a prestigious professor at the University of Salamanca in 1892-1919 and a renovator of legal science in Spain. The building, built in the first half of the 15th century, was organized around a cloistered courtyard and it only had one floor, with frontage facing Plaza de Anaya and Calle Libreros, the latter being the most important
